<b>DIRECTIVE TITLE:</b>	Registering State, Local, Campus, and Tribal Students in FLETC Training Programs
<b>EFFECTIVE DATE:</b>	5/20/2006

---

**1. POLICY:** Training allocations will be distributed to state, local, campus, and tribal law enforcement agencies in an equitable manner, taking into consideration the demand and potential impact on particular training needs.

**2. SCOPE:** This directive applies to Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC) personnel involved in the selection and assignment of all state, local, campus, and tribal students into Center Advanced and State and Local Programs, whether conducted at a FLETC facility, through the internet, or as export programs. This directive does not apply to recertification programs such as the routine firearms recertification programs at Cheltenham.
