FLETC DIRECTIVE NO:	33-01
DIRECTIVE TITLE:	Funding Guidelines for Training
EFFECTIVE DATE:	5/17/2005

1. POLICY: Training at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC) will be funded either by FLETC's annual appropriation or by the trainee's organization on a reimbursable basis.

2. SCOPE: The provisions of this directive apply to all basic, advanced, requalification, State and local, and international training provided by the FLETC. It also applies to all FLETC organizational elements and Partner Organizations (POs) involved in training allocations and/or reimbursements for training provided by the FLETC.
