DIRECTIVE TITLE:	Research Review Board (RRB)
EFFECTIVE DATE:	5/20/2006

- 1. POLICY:** All research conducted at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC) that involves human subjects will be conducted in a manner that protects the rights of the subjects and minimizes potential risk. A Research Review Board (RRB) will review all research proposals using human subjects in a manner consistent with mission requirements and as required by the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR).
- 2. SCOPE:** This directive applies to all FLETC locations and training sites and contains elements that apply to all FLETC staff, Partner Organization (PO) representatives and staff, students, guests, and contractor personnel.
