FLETC DIRECTIVE NO:	70-09.C
DIRECTIVE TITLE:	Severe Weather Notification and Response
EFFECTIVE DATE:	2/5/2006

1. POLICY: The Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC) will establish and maintain mechanisms to notify FLETC, Partner Organization (PO), and contractor staff; students; and visitors of severe weather emergencies, as well as procedures for the termination of outdoor training and other activities that occur in an outdoor venue when such activities could place people in danger.

2. SCOPE: This directive applies to all FLETC, PO, and contractor personnel; students; and visitors at all FLETC facilities (i.e., Glynco, Georgia; Artesia, New Mexico; Cheltenham, Maryland; and Charleston, South Carolina; and the Washington Operations Office, Washington, D.C.).
