FLETC DIRECTIVE NO:	70-09.F
DIRECTIVE TITLE:	Hurricane Response Plan for the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center
EFFECTIVE DATE:	6/16/2005

1. POLICY: The Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC) will monitor all tropical weather conditions having potential impact in the area of FLETC sites. Procedures and responsibilities will be established to prepare for and respond to the threat or landfall of a hurricane or severe tropical storm. In accordance with established procedures, appropriate actions will be implemented to ensure the safety of personnel and the protection of property, including FLETC site- and organization-specific actions to provide accommodations for persons with disabilities.

2. SCOPE: This directive applies to all employees of the FLETC, FLETC Partner Organizations, and FLETC students. The FLETC, Glynco, Hurricane Response Plan accompanies this directive and is applicable to the FLETC, Glynco. Additionally the FLETC, Glynco, Hurricane Response Plan will be used as a general guideline in preparing for and responding to tropical storm conditions at the FLETC, Cheltenham, and FLETC, Charleston, training sites until such time as specific plans are developed for those sites.
