1. POLICY: At the direction of the responsible Assistant Director, training related accidents which involve students, staff, Partner Organizations (POs), and contractors will be investigated promptly by a Training Accident Investigation Team (TAIT).

2. SCOPE: This directive applies to all FLETC training sites.
