<b>DIRECTIVE TITLE:</b>	Security, Handling, and Inventory of Controlled Substances
<b>EFFECTIVE DATE:</b>	04/08/2008

---

**1. POLICY:** Maximum security and accountability of controlled substances will be maintained at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC) training facilities at all times.

**2. SCOPE:** The provisions of this directive apply to all FLETC personnel involved in the handling of controlled substances. Requests for training requiring the use of controlled substances at all FLETC facilities will be submitted from the Deputy Assistant Director (DAD) with oversight (or his/her designee) for approval to their appropriate Assistant Director with oversight. Each request will be assessed on a case-by-case basis by the Assistant Director (or his/her designee).
