<b>DIRECTIVE TITLE:</b>	Visits to FLETC Facilities by Foreign Nationals
<b>EFFECTIVE DATE:</b>	8/7/2006

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**1. POLICY:** All applicable laws, policies, and procedures governing the conduct of United States counter-intelligence activities will be strictly observed when planning, approving, conducting, and reporting visits by foreign nationals to the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC), including its field sites and any International Law Enforcement Academy (ILEA) managed by the FLETC.

**2. SCOPE:** This directive applies to all individuals and organizations (including FLETC, Partner Organization (PO), and FLETC-managed ILEA staff members) that propose, request, and/or conduct visits by foreign nationals to FLETC facilities in the United States and at FLETC-managed ILEAs.
