

FFF FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

1. Can I donate pet food to the FFF campaign?

Pet food is not listed on the food bank's Most Wanted List of items. However, if donations of this type are made, the food banks will donate the items to their local animal shelter.

2. Am I responsible for weighing food that I donate?

All donations will be weighed on a regularly scheduled basis by volunteers from the FFF committee. Please ensure your donations are placed in a designated bin for delivery or pickup.

3. Where are donation bins located?

A list of areas where bins are located will be published on the FFF website, or contact your representative for locations accessible to you.

4. Can I donate cash for purchasing food?

FFF Ethics Rules prohibit the donation or collection of cash for this campaign. However, you may purchase items online to avoid making a trip to the store or transporting items to your office location. Information on making online donations is available on the FFF website. Go to the Ways to Donate through Feds Feed Families section and click on the Online Shopping link.

5. I have an idea for an activity to encourage donations. What should I do next?

Representatives have been designated to assist with the campaign. Please go to the FFF website for information on the point of contact in your area. Your representative will inform you of the next steps for having your idea reviewed for approval.
